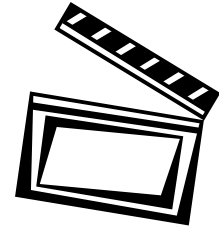


# Entertainment and Media Career Community

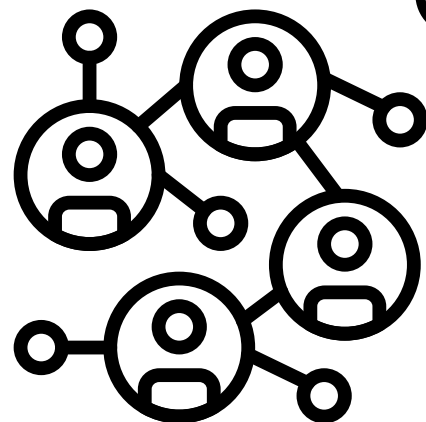
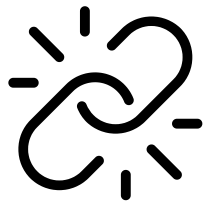

- Spanning 1 day to several months

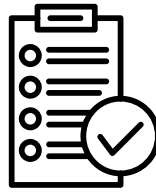
## Internships
