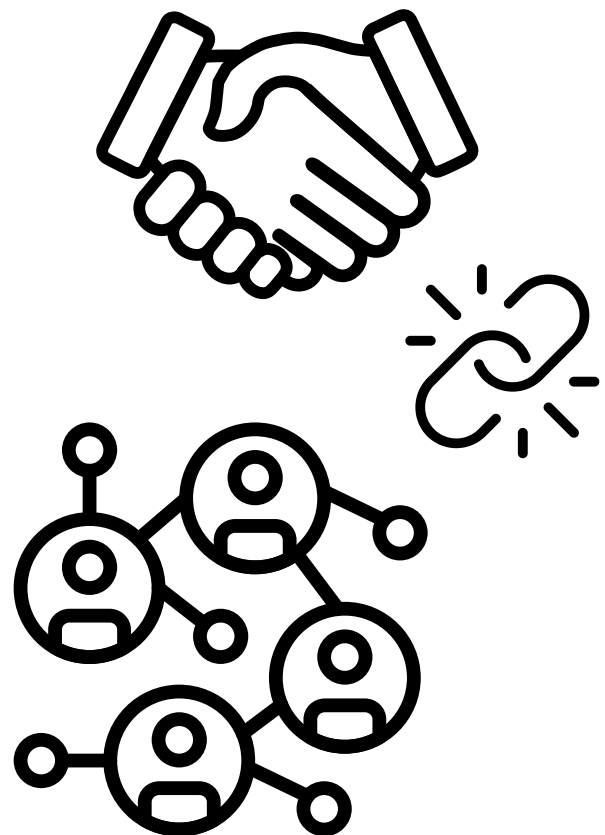

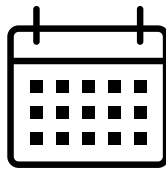

- Winter & Spring for actively identifying and applying to opportunities

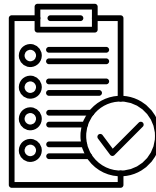
Internships

- The larger the organization and the more well-known, the earlier the application deadline
- Winter quarter (Jan-March) typically for established internship programs
- Spring quarter (March-May) typically for smaller organizations opportunities
